1. Briefly summarize your own spiritual history.
2. List any previous ministry involvement and tell about your present church participation (including attendance). This will be different for every person and for some this may be "only the beginning" of your experience. Please explain.
3. Describe briefly and generally the present dynamics of your marriage from your point of view, including patterns of communication. You need not give specifics.
4. Describe in some detail your present schedule including all weekly and monthly commitments (work, school, sports, clubs, lessons, and activities with your own children, etc.).
5. Which, if any, of the above commitments would you be willing to drop in order to make time for Marriage Plus (4 hrs. /wk.)?
6. Having read the **following** statements, **mission, philosophy, and doctrinal**, please summarize in your own words the goals of Marriage Plus.
7. Tell why you personally want to commit the hours to the Marriage Plus training.
8. While this course is very practical, the foundation is spiritual. By this we mean that you will be challenged to work, to grow and to change. All of this will test your devotion, not only to your marriage, but also to Christ. For this reason, we ask each of you to affirm the statement of faith on the **last page of the application** by adding your signature.

Sample Application

This will help you know how much detail to include in your application.

1. As a child I was raised in a Catholic family. We went to church regularly, but as I grew older and started playing sports, I went to church less often. I always "believed" in God, but it wasn't until I was in my last year of college that I wanted to learn more about Jesus. I accepted Jesus as my Savior at the age of 23, so my time as a believer has been short. Over the past two years I have seen tremendous growth in my knowledge of God's Word, and in my desire to strengthen my relationship with the Lord.

2. I haven't had much ministry experience, but I am active in a Bible study and I help prepare the lessons when it is my turn. I also like to share the Gospel with others. We are excited to learn new ministry skills.

3. My mate is my best friend, and we love spending time together. We struggle sometimes with how to manage our time since both of us work. Communication is sometimes great and sometimes awful. There are times when we don't seem to understand each other at all. But we are very committed to learn and grow in our marriage.

4. My schedule during the week is
